VETERAN CAMPER ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

To register as a Veteran Camper at the \$175 price the following requirements must be met:

Veteran Camper Requirements:

1. The Camper must provide the following items (i.e., will NOT be provided by the Virginia War Museum):
 - a. 1 Combat Sporter Toy Gun as issued in Camp. No Airsoft, BB or other toy gun may be utilized.
 - b. 1 Plain Olive Green Knapsack, No Camouflage or any color but Olive Green.
 - c. Canteen or water bottle.
2. The Camper will be responsible for their own Gun, Knapsack, Canteen and
 - a. Must bring them and take them home daily.
 - b. Must clearly label it with the campers name in Black.
 - c. The Museum will not replace broken or lost personal items.
3. On the first day of camp at check in, the Veteran Camper will be inspected by the camp staff to ensure they have the appropriate toy gun/knapsack. If the camper shows up with inappropriate material they will be required to go to the Museum Gift shop and purchase the items at Full retail price. Children without the required material cannot participate and their fee WILL NOT be refunded.
