December 7: Pearl Harbor Day Memorial Ceremony. 4:00 pm – 5:00 pm.

This annual event features a presentation and film, in the museum theater and is followed by a wreath-laying ceremony, at the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association monument on the grounds adjacent to the museum. A special display of rare artifacts from the Pearl Harbor attack will also be on display, including a Japanese propeller from a plane that was shot down during the attack. This event is free and open to the public. Afterwards, be sure to visit the museum galleries and learn about the America's military heritage from 1775 to the present day at the usual admission rates.
